



Construction on our new "Little Futures" Classrooms, game rooms, new teen rooms and program spaces officially finished in May 2023! When "Little Futures" Preschool opened in 2019, it occupied only one small room at the front of the building. As the need for this kind of care in our community became more and more apparent, the preschool expanded to fill a second room, but the need only grew in response! We required larger rooms to cater to more students, improved lighting, access to other areas of the building, and a space tailored to our children and their unique requirements.

Renovations on what is now two all-new classrooms, a new games room and an E-Sports Room began at the end of 2022, as the next step in a series of building renovations that began in 2020. These renovations would not be possible without the Block Grant funding from West Springfield Community Development and essential help from Caolo & Bieniek Associates, Inc., the members of our Building & Safety Committee, and support from the Irene & George A Davis Foundation. These rooms have been transformed into state-of-the-art classrooms for our members, from preschool to high school.

These spaces feature welcoming ceilings, freshly painted walls and fun floors, and are filled with natural and overhead light. The new "Little Futures" classrooms opened to students on Monday, May 22nd, and boast their own bathroom and field access. As part of these extensive renovations, the Club was also able to upgrade the HVAC system in the building, something that was sorely needed! The upgraded facilities are not only better at heating and cooling, but have a lower environmental impact as well as keeping the air cleaner and safer for our members and staff.




SO, ALEXUS, TELL US WHAT YOUR PLANS ARE FOR THE FUTURE? WHAT DO YOU SEE YOURSELF DOING NEXT?

The Club has made such a big impact on me, educationally socially and professionally. I've made so many relationships with the kids and with the staff. I feel like this experience has made me more empathetic and compassionate, better at seeing other people's points of view. There are quite a few jobs I can do with a degree in Child Psychology, like a social worker, or a school counselor. So I haven't totally decided yet what I'm going to do in the future, I'm trying to focus on what I'm doing at the Club right now, and what I'm doing at school. But I know I want to work with kids, which isn't something I had ever really imagined for myself before my experience here at the Club.

BREAKING NEWS: NEW TEEN PROGRAM

On October 16th, 2023, the West Springfield Boys & Girls Club launched a brand-new program that provides a space where 6th-8th graders can learn new skills, play sports, and participate in a community space designed especially for them. For a membership fee of only \$25, members of our "Middle School Drop-In Program" gain access to the building and a rotating schedule of activities between 5:30 and 7 PM each weekday throughout the entire school year.

This initiative provides an inclusive space for all young people, regardless of their financial situation, featuring activities aimed at supporting and preparing this vital age group for the future. Contrary to our usual After School programs, the "Middle School Drop-In Program" runs later into the evening, allowing members to personalize their experiences. Participants in this program are encouraged to take ownership of the space, create a community with their peers, and choose their interests from a variety of available programming.

On Mondays, members choose between sports in the gym or "Art with Amanda," where they can learn drawing, painting and jewelry-making techniques.

Tuesdays offer an opportunity for "Pizza with a Professional," where interested members meet with mentors from a variety of different careers and industries.
